

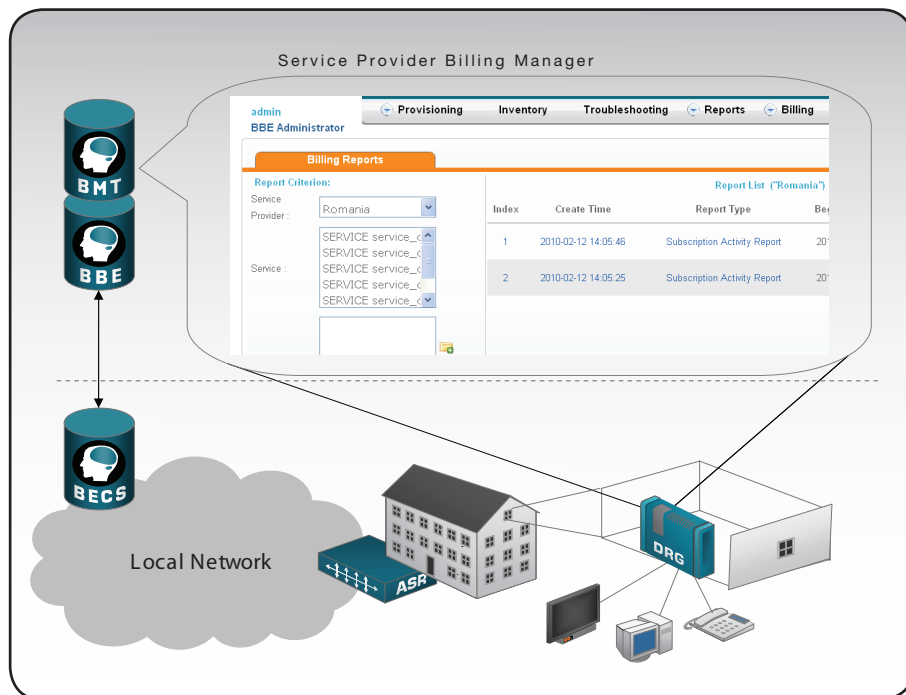
BBE - Billing Management Tool

The Billing Management Tool (BMT) is an application within the BBE (Broadband Business Engine) product family. BMT provides the data needed for efficient billing of services in broadband networks.

BMT is used to produce detailed reports concerning subscription activities and service duration. These reports are then used by the network operator to bill the service providers. BMT does not only give the network operator up-to-date information on what is happening in the network, but also provides detailed information concerning individual service usage of the service provider products.

All reports are stored in the BMT repository as both a summary version and a detailed version that can be downloaded as a comma separated (.csv) file for further analysis in external applications, such as MS Excel or Crystal Reports.

Subscription Activity

The Subscription Activity report is used to determine the amount of activity for customers subscribed to a specific service provider. Reports can calculate all subscription activities by defining service provider, service, customer group (Coverage Node), and

also the timeframe.

The Summary report lists the report criteria and a summary of all subscription activities for the specified period, and the detailed report contains all database records that match the report criteria. The detailed report contains the data from each individual customer record, for example:

- Name
- Delivery Address
- Activity
- Service
- Product

Service Duration

The Service Duration report is used to calculate detailed reports for service usage. The report calculates the number of days that a specific service has been active for a customer, given a service provider, service, customer group (Coverage Node) and a timeframe.

The summary contains the criteria for the report and a summary of the service usage, and the detailed report contains all database records that matched the report criteria.

The detailed report contains the data from each individual customer record, for example:

- Name
- Delivery Address
- Service
- Product
- Service Duration
